MOTHER OF HEALING LOVE

We re-visit the *Running Nuns: Daughters of Mary, Mother of Healing Love* (DMMHL) as a focus of our prayer for vocations. These sisters are now making a point of visiting the social gatherings of our three churches, such as the Friday Lenten meals and other meals after liturgies. They are moving into the old campus of Magdalene College in Warner, New Hampshire to transform it into a Shrine and Retreat Center. They have hiked over 800 miles in Eucharistic procession to join 60,000 people at the Eucharistic Congress, and led 32 NH Eucharistic Pilgrimages. They serve additional apostolates including:

- Prayer and Eucharistic Adoration
- Family Faith Formation
- Family Intergenerational Reconciliation and Reunification
- Catholic School Education
- Physical Therapy
- Speech Therapy
- Retreats (including guest speaking and videos)
- Spiritual Direction & Accompaniment, including through their music CDs, books, art, and video talks (which can be found at their website gift shop)
- Healing prayer
- Sacred Heart Enthronement in the home
- Lifeline Against Suicide Prayer Team
- Works of evangelization.

ON HOLY SATURDAY parishioners bring baskets full of food to the church to be blessed (*Święconka*) by the priest. In times past parish priests would visit each home. The scene on the Easter collage above depicts the blessing in the church yard. The rolling hills of the Polish fields in springtime are in the background, along with the church, and a typical home with stork on the chimney. The farmer in his cart is on his way to the fields while geese and ducks roam nearby. The wayside shrine portrayed can be seen on a typical country road in Poland.

In the foreground are ladies and children in native costumes. Food, spread out on a white tablecloth, has been prepared on the last few days of Lent to be blessed and consumed after sunrise Mass on Easter Sunday.

People strictly fasted during Lent. Easter is the time to feast on ham, decorated eggs, salt, horseradish, sweet breads, and wine.

The priest and altar boy are shown ready to bless both people and food. The surplice worn by the priest is an actual one worn by the late Fr. John Blazewicz, MS. He donated his vestment for this tapestry but never saw the completed work. Fr. Blazewicz passed away just after Christmas, 1975.

Flowers, symbolic of springtime and the Resurrection, adorn the entire scene.
